



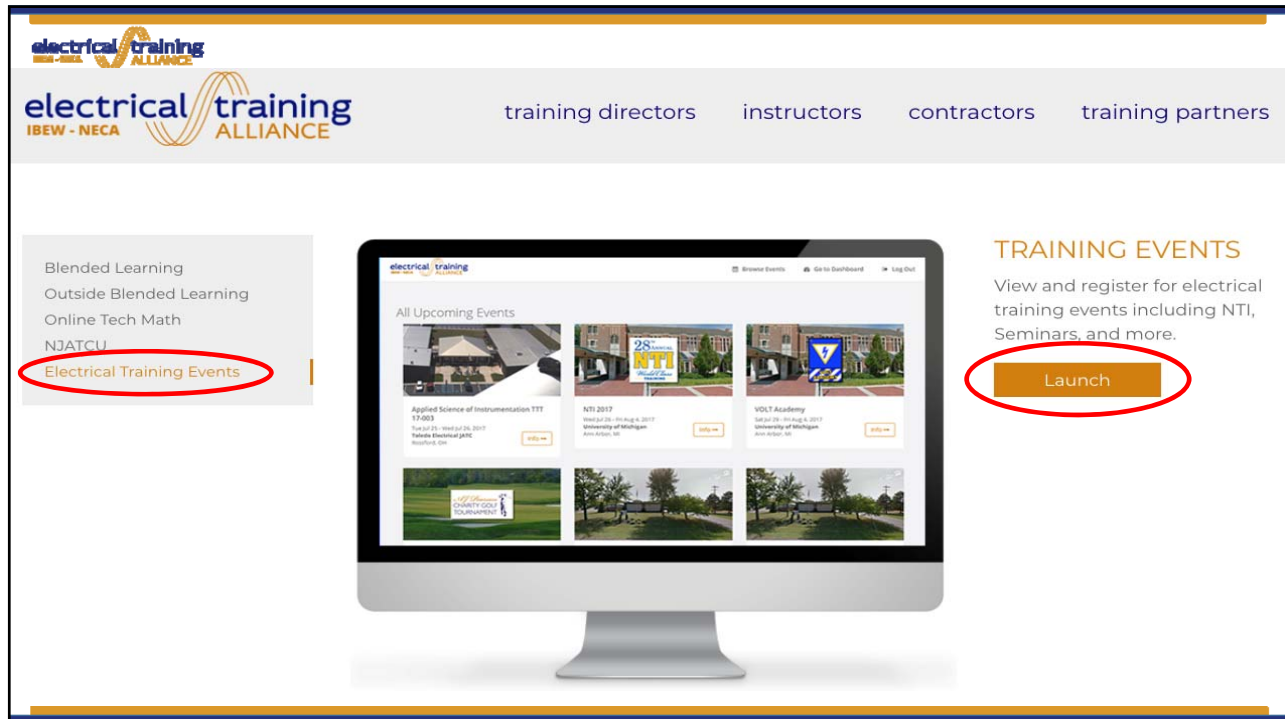

Training Class Needs

- etA will assist in scheduling a class where a training need is identified

 - Course description (if not already an etA class)
 - Learning objectives expected from training (Certification needed, job requirements, etc)
 - Location training will take place
 - Date training needs to be completed
 - Approximate number that need to be trained in your area

Test Administrator Training/Selection Process

- We offer 6 – 8 classes per year
 - 3 classes left for 2018 (Reno, NV -Lima, OH - Jacksonville, FL)
 - Classes are 14 hours
 - All programs should have multiple Test Administrators
- Aptitude Test – 2 options – Paper/Pencil & Online
- Additional tests are being developed
- Interview Training
 - 1 day training for committee members
- New interview questions are now being beta tested



Medium Voltage Book/Course

- New medium voltage book and course under development
- We are developing an overview course to allow electrical workers (inside and outside) to gain a general knowledge of medium voltage distribution installations
- Safety will be a major component along with these topic areas:
 - Power theory, application, design, specifications, and installation of medium voltage equipment
- Major manufacturers are assisting on this project
- Will be an LMS course
- Completion target is 2019



Traffic Signal Technician Program

- Three-year Traffic Signal Technician program is being reviewed, revised and updated
- All lessons are being converted to the LMS format
- 1st year should be ready for the fall 2019 school year
- 2nd year ready by 2020, 3rd year ready by 2021

Medium Voltage Cable Splicing Training

- All Modules are offered throughout the year at several different training centers
 - See schedule for dates and locations
- All Modules are under review for revision
 - Plan to have Modules I and IV revised in 2019
 - New foundation book will be used – Alexander – Cable Splicer's Handbook
 - Demand is increasing for qualified cable splicers
- Module supply kits – tapes and components can be ordered through Graybar – very quick turnaround

Medium Voltage Cable Splicing - Certification

- National Cable Splicing Certification Board (NCSCB)
- Testing is normally scheduled after Module IV classes and various times and locations throughout the year
 - Three main testing areas: Medway, OH (ALBAT), Trenton, NJ (LU 269 JATC), and San Bernardino, CA (LU440/477 JATC)
 - At various business locations
- Testing costs:
 - Written Exam testing fee \$295.00
 - Manufactured Kit examination fee \$1,200.00
 - Hand-Applied Tape exam fee \$1,200.00
 - There are fee for retesting

Pre-Apprenticeship Program

- 3rd Year of 5 year grant will be completed 9/30/2018
- To date 640 have started the program with 190 more to start over the next 3 months.
- To date 550 have completed or are currently enrolled in the program
- To date 336 are registered apprentices or working to become RA's
- Program consists of 220 classroom hours, and a minimum of 80 OJT hours
- This program will be available to all JATC's shortly
